
What are the hours?

8am-8pm, the splash pad is on a timer. To activate the water, press the button at the NE corner of the splash pad.

Where is the splash pad located?

The splash pad is located between

- Plum Street (to the South)
- Monroe Street (to the North)
- Main Street (to the West)
- Washington Street (to the East)



Where do I park?

Parking is available in the following locations (these locations are noted by blue squares on the above map):

- Lock One Parking Lot (3-hour time limit)
- Behind the New Bremen Public Library
- Crown Pavilion (limited parking available)

Are restrooms available? Yes, full-service restrooms are available at Crown Pavilion.

Is there a water fountain nearby? Yes

Is the water chlorinated? Yes. The water is treated to the same standards as a public swimming pool or spa.

Are there other things to do at the splash pad? Komminsk Legacy Park is an interactive park, the splash pad is one of the features. Other features include amphitheater seating perfect for a picnic, several musical instruments for sound play, a concrete slide and climbable lions.

Are pets allowed? The same rules apply, regarding pets in public places, as it does in the other parts of our community (must be on a leash and owner is responsible for removal of an excreta deposited by his or her animal immediately after being left by said animal).
