Roll call showed the following members present for the meeting on this date at 6:30 p.m. Larger, Condon, Wuebker, Burnell, Elshoff and Lomakin. Also, present were Solicitor This, Mayor Parker, Chief Skinner. Village Administrator Richter and Fiscal Officer Speelman were absent.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Condon.

Visitors attending were Erin Gardner from The Daily Standard.

Minutes from the September 11, 2023 regular meeting were approved. Motion by Lomakin. Second by Larger. Six ayes.

Larger reported total expenditures for September in the amount of \$1,653,622.72 and total receipts for August were \$1,715,649.29; noted Finance committee reviewed bank reconciliations for August. Motion by Larger. Second by Condon. Six ayes.

Mayor Parker's Report:

- SR 274 Waterline project and Curb project are complete.

Village Administrator Richter Report:

- No report

OPWC applications are due October 3. Working with engineer for a reconstruction of Vine St, Park St and Walnut St from Front St to Monroe St. This project would complete this section of the village. Burnell made a motion to suspend the rule. Second by Lomakin. Six ayes. Declaring Emergency Resolution 2023-09-12 Authorize Village Administrator to submit application to OPWC for Park St, Vine St and Walnut St Reconstruction. Motion by Wuebker. Second by Lomakin. Six ayes.

Need to create a Then and Now purchase order to encumber \$4,367.20 to Core & Main for the emergency purchase of product to repair a water line on State Route 274. The PO was missed due to an emergency need over a weekend.

Lomakin made a motion to suspend the rule. Second by Larger. Six ayes. Declaring Emergency Resolution 2023-09-13 Approve Then and Now purchase order to Core & Main for \$4,367.20. Motion by Elshoff. Second by Condon. Six ayes.

Komminsk Farm Ground bid opening was August 31, 2023. 4 sealed bids were received. High bid was Ethan Fite from Mann Farms in Jackson Center, Ohio with a bid of \$142,506 for 3 year lease term. Second Reading Ordinance 2023-09-19 Contract lease of Komminsk Farm Ground for 2024, 2025 and 2026.
