

COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN

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10-28-24

Roll call showed the following members present for the meeting on this date at 6:30 p.m. Larger, Burnell, Lomakin, Condon, Hurley and Bertke. Also, present were Solicitor This, Fiscal Officer Speelman, Chief Skinner and Mayor Parker. Village Administrator Richter was absent.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Condon.

Visitors attending were Erin Gardner from The Daily Standard.

Minutes from the October 14, 2024 regular meeting were approved. Motion by Bertke. Second by Condon. Six ayes.

Larger reported total expenditures for October in the amount of \$1,098,003.37 and total receipts for September were \$1,420,517.13; noted Finance committee reviewed bank reconciliations for September. Motion by Larger. Second by Bertke. Six ayes.

Mayor Parker's Report:

Village Administrator Richter Report:

- Completed final phosphorus and ammonia plans for OEPA. Awaiting review.
- Plum St Reconstruction project – Last pay app is in process of approval.
- Jefferson St retaining wall is being installed to eliminate the steep bank for mowing.

As part of the ODOT 2025 paving on State Route 274, the village is also field paving the invert of bridge type culvert on SR 274, including erosion control and pipe clean out. This will be paid 100% by the village with an engineer's estimate of \$169,090.
