Roll call showed the following members present for the meeting on this date at 6:30 p.m. Larger, Burnell, Lomakin, Condon, Hurley and Bertke. Also, present were Solicitor This, Fiscal Officer Speelman, Chief Skinner, Mayor Parker and Village Administrator Richter.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Condon.

Minutes from the October 28, 2024 regular meeting were approved. Motion by Condon. Second by Bertke. Six ayes.

Mayor Parker's Report:

Village Administrator Richter Report:

- Dry ice blasting at the pool is going well.
- Bremenfest West Shelter House renovation is 50% complete.
- Jefferson St retaining wall is being installed to eliminate the steep bank for mowing. This project will be complete in the next few weeks.

Water plant salt bid opening was November 8. Artesian of Pioneer was the sole bid at \$178/ton. No change from change from current price.

As part of the ODOT 2025 paving on State Route 274, the village is also field paving the invert of bridge type culvert on SR 274, including erosion control and pipe clean out. This will be paid 100% by the village with an engineer's estimate of \$169,090.
