Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Condon.

Bertke made a motion at 6:02 p.m. to enter executive session for purchase or sale of property. Second by Larger. Six ayes. Bertke made a motion at 6:15 p.m. to come out of executive session. Second by Larger. Six ayes.

Request to amend 2025 appropriations in the amount of \$2,838,150.00 for the purchase of land for total appropriations of \$26,099,222.26.

Hurley made a motion to suspend the rule. Second by Bertke. Six ayes. Declaring Emergency Ordinance 2025-09-17 Amend 2025 Appropriations. Motion by Larger. Second by Burnell. Six ayes.

Village attended public auction on September 13 of two land tracts owned by The Late Greg and Yolanda Schmiesing Farm ETAL along State Route 274 and Amsterdam Rd. The village bid and was awarded 90.10 acre tract at \$31,500 per acre for a total of \$2,838,150.00. Comprised of four parcels – C0901600900, C0901600800, C0901600700 and C0901601000, 88.8090 acres of tillable ground. Land will be held for any future growth opportunities for the village.
